The 2015 Funding Opportunity Announcements will be out soon and ANA Eastern Region Training and Technical Assistance Center will be offering a Pre-Application Training at the end of the 2014 USET Annual Meeting. The training is designed to provide prospective ANA applicants with "nuts and bolts" information on: the federal application process and the ANA Funding Opportunity Announcements for Social and Economic Development Strategies (SEDS), Native Language Preservation and Maintenance, and Environmental Regulatory Enhancement.

Participants learn how to:

- Register and apply on www.grants.gov;
- Understand the ANA Funding Opportunity Announcement Evaluation Criteria;
- Format, package, structure and submit an application for ANA funding consideration.

The training session is offered free of charge to tribes and American Indian, Native Hawaiian, Alaska Native, and other Native American Pacific Islander non-profit organizations. Each participant is responsible for paying their own travel costs to attend. Pre-application training participants should have a defined project idea. At registration, participants will be asked to submit a summary of the proposed project, including goal and objectives.
