Dear Tribal Leader:

The U.S. Department of Homeland Security, Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) is committed to engaging in government-to-government consultation with tribal officials on actions that affect Tribal Nations. This is described in [FEMA's Tribal Consultation Policy](#) and is in accordance with [Executive Order 13175](#) and President Biden's "[Memorandum on Tribal Consultation and Strengthening Nation-to-Nation Relationships](#)." FEMA's goals in the [2022-2026 FEMA National Tribal Strategy](#) also emphasize our commitment to honor tribal sovereignty and build and maintain strong relationships with tribal governments.

Consistent with these commitments, FEMA invites Tribal Nations to attend tribal consultations on the regulations, policies, and procedures governing FEMA's Radiological Emergency Preparedness (REP) Program. The consultations are scheduled to take place on **July 30, 2024** (2:00-4:00 PM EST) and **August 1, 2024** (2:00-4:00 PM EST). FEMA is committed to ensuring all participants have equal access regardless of disability status. The REP Program coordinates the national effort to provide state, local, and tribal governments with relevant and executable planning, training, and exercise guidance and policies necessary to ensure that adequate capabilities exist to prevent, protect against, mitigate the effects of, respond to, and recover from incidents involving commercial nuclear power facilities.
